ingredients

TOOLS YOU'LL NEED

white cover stock (approx. 10-15 sheets)
twine
scissors –or– xacto knife & ruler
invisible tape

GET CREATIVE WITH

use different strings like fishing line!

SUGGESTED USE

photobooth backdrop
dessert table decor / backdrop

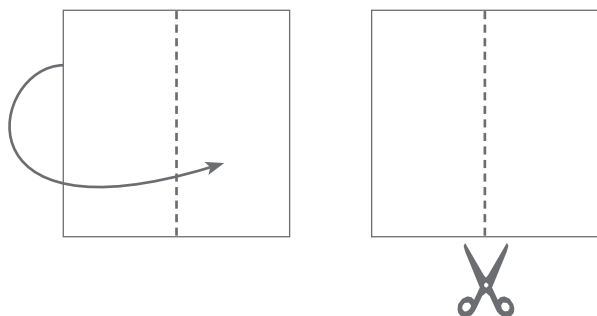
step-by-step

STEP #1

Print desired amount of color squares (pages 2-6 of this PDF). Each square yields 8 triangles.

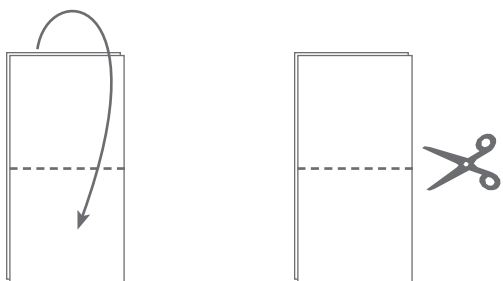
STEP #2

Cut out 1 color square & fold it in half then cut along the fold line.



STEP #3

Stack the 2 resulting rectangles together. Fold them in half to make a square & cut along the fold line.



STEP #4

Stack all 4 squares together, fold them diagonally in half & cut along the fold line. Repeat steps 2-4 with other colors to create as many triangles as necessary.



STEP #5

Trim twine to desired length. Using tape or glue gun, affix twine to the back of triangles. Create a pattern where some triangles touch the base of another triangle & others are spaced apart approximately the height of a triangle. Affix finished strands to wall with invisible tape. Bravo! Enjoy the party!

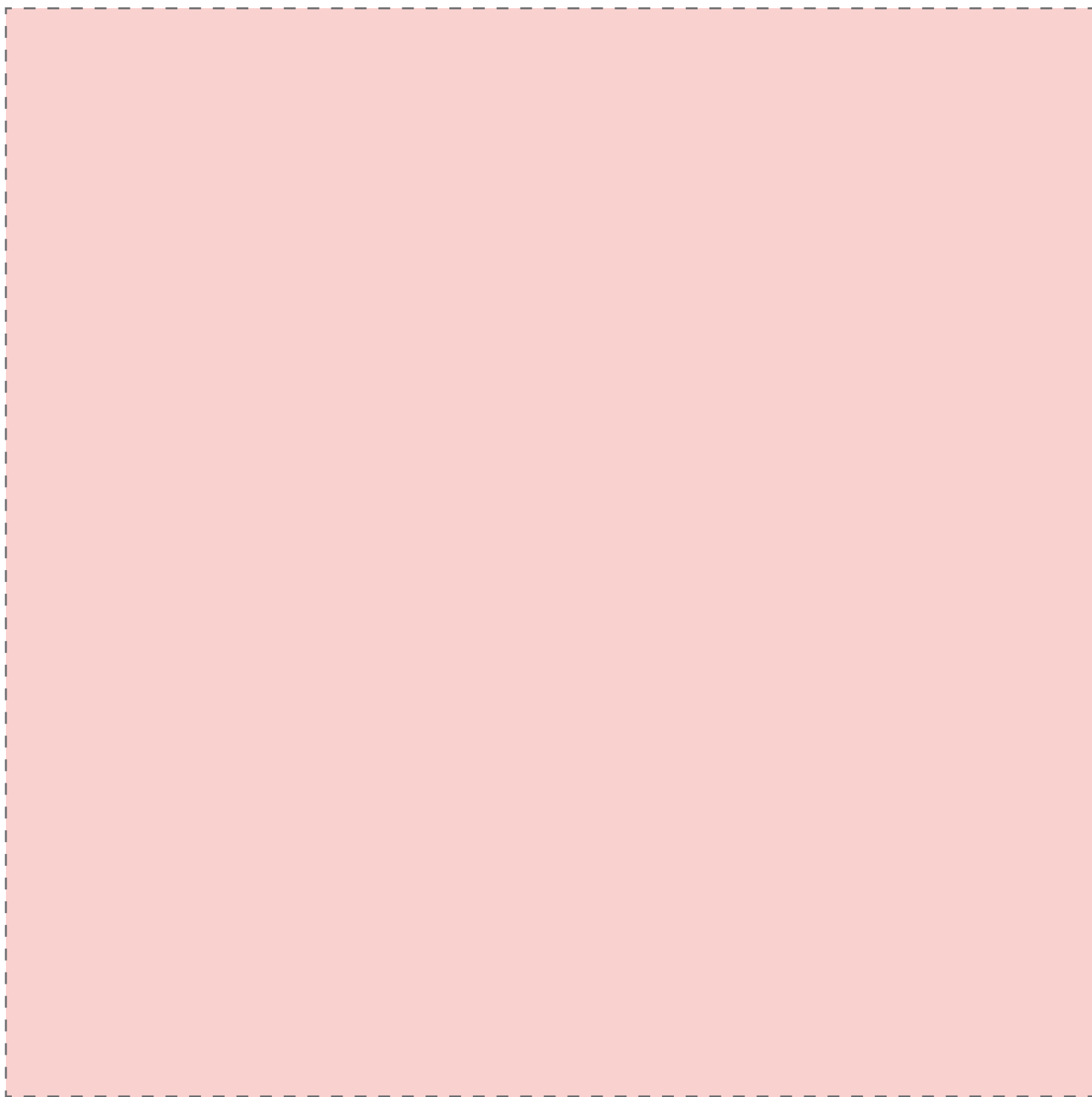
NOTE: AMOUNT OF TRIANGLES WILL VARY WITH DESIRED BACKDROP DIMENSIONS.

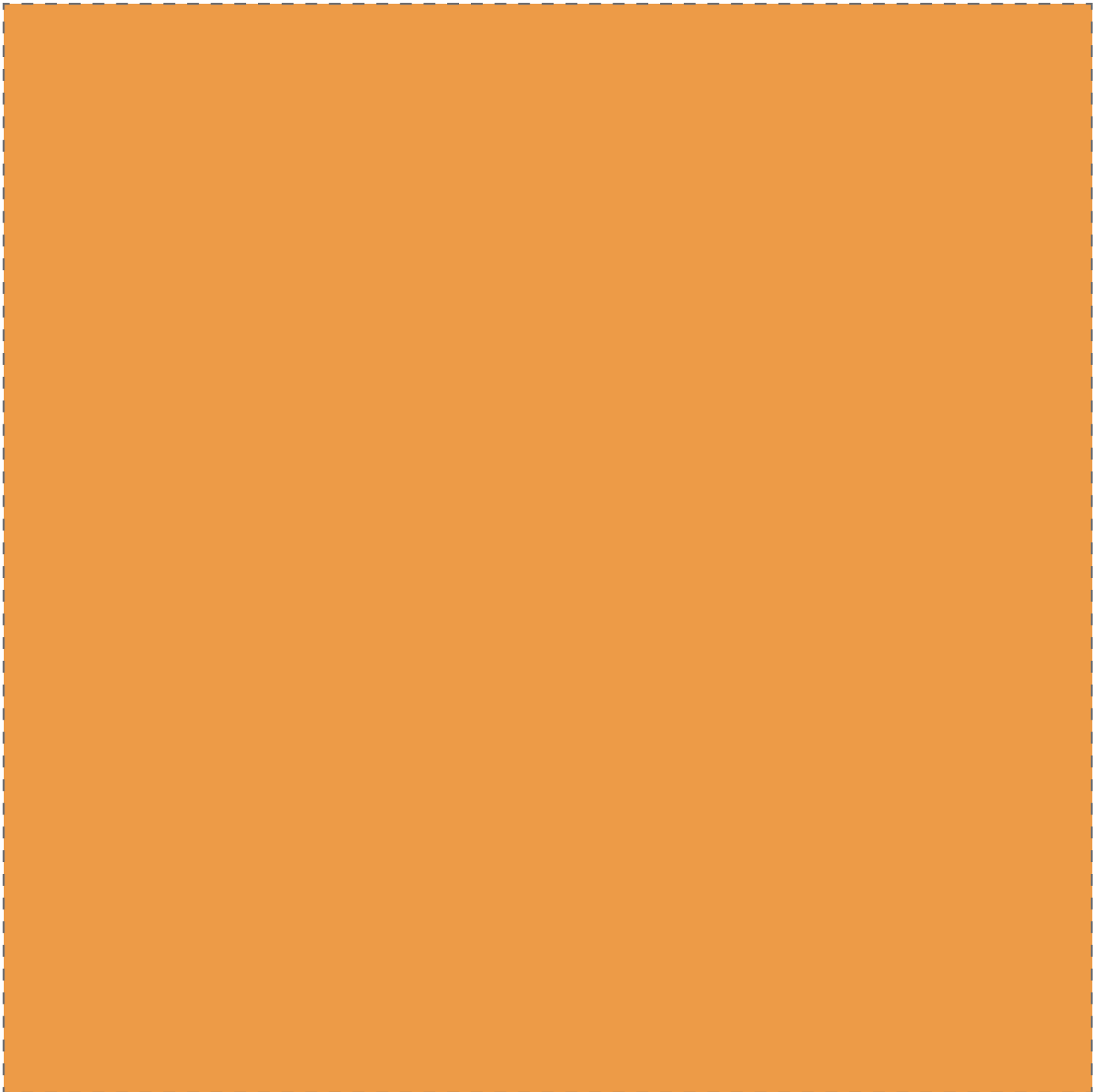

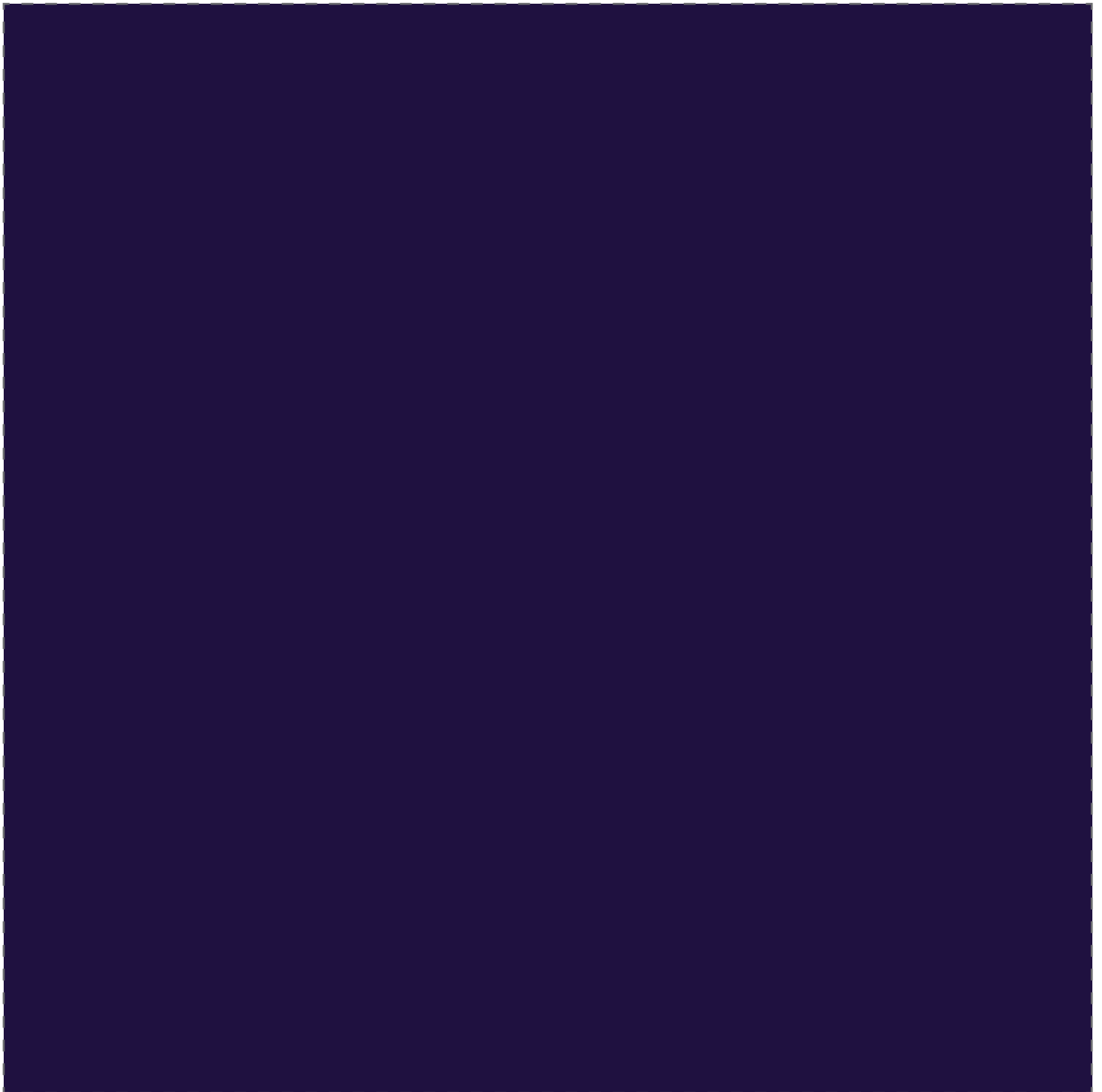
